## FINAL ORDER


Dear Steve:

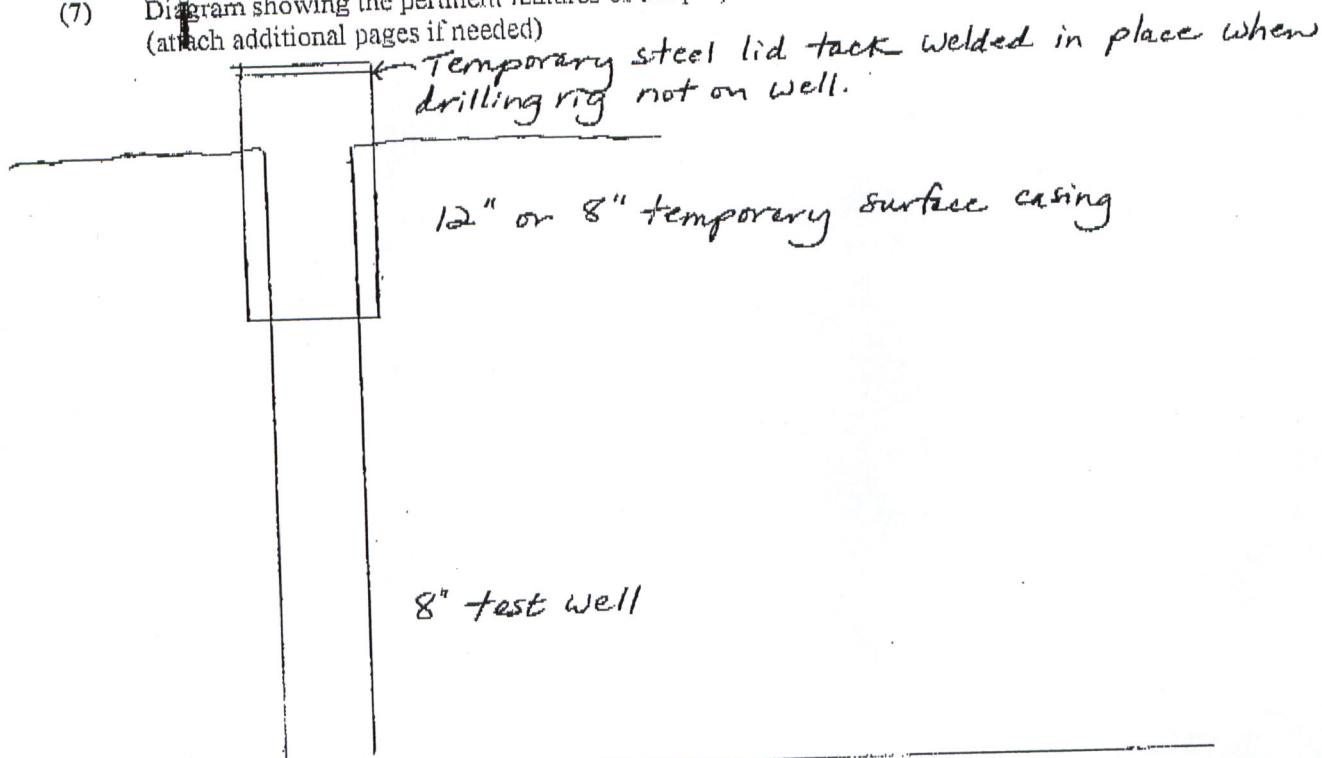

(5) The unusual site conditions which necessitate this request: We are drilling up to (4) wells on (2) adjoining properties under (2) water right applications G-17010 & G-17011. These permits have multiple conditions that require possible packer isolation tests, intermittent pump tests and drill cuttings analysis. This will require time that does not require a drill rig to be onsite over the well. (continued in item #6)

(6) The proposed construction methods that the bonded well constructor believes will be adequate for this well: (attach additional pages if needed) We would like the flexibility to move the drill rig around from well to well to keep drilling and return to each well as field conditions make that well ready for the drill rig. Each well will have temporary surface casing installed when drill rig is not onsite or other work is being performed on that well, a steel lid will be tack welded to cover up well head. At no time will the drill rig be leaving the larger site until all wells are cased and sealed.

- (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior oral approval.

*REVISED LOCATION* MARION COUNTY

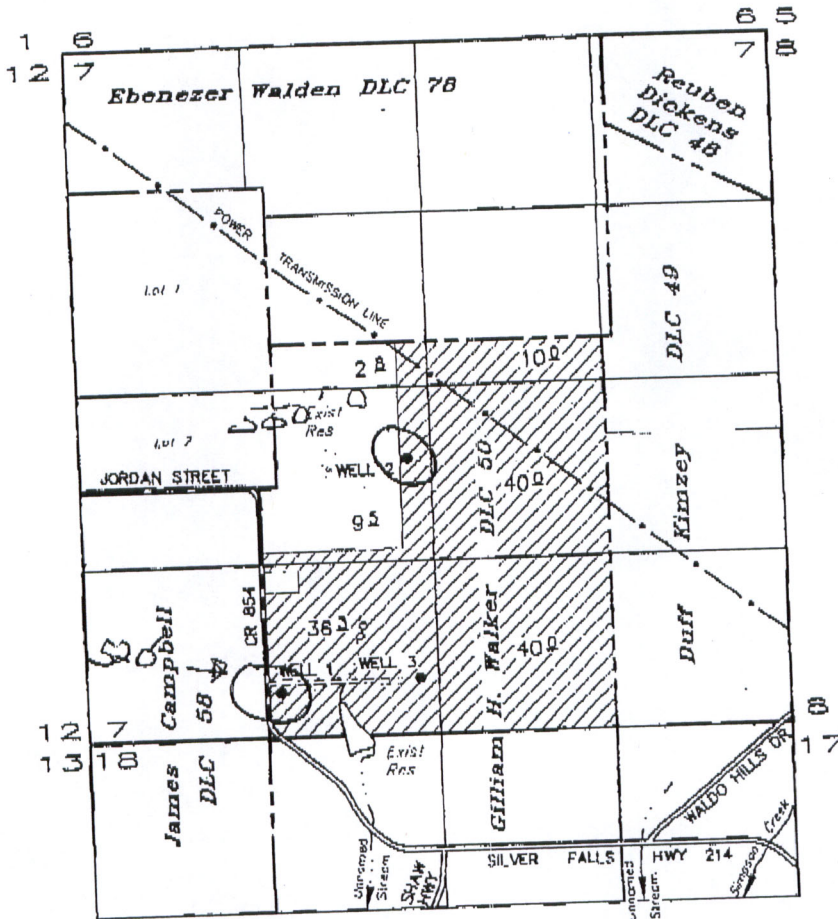

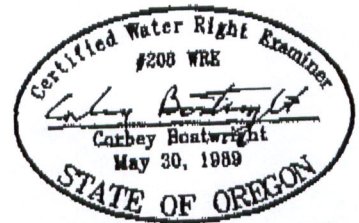

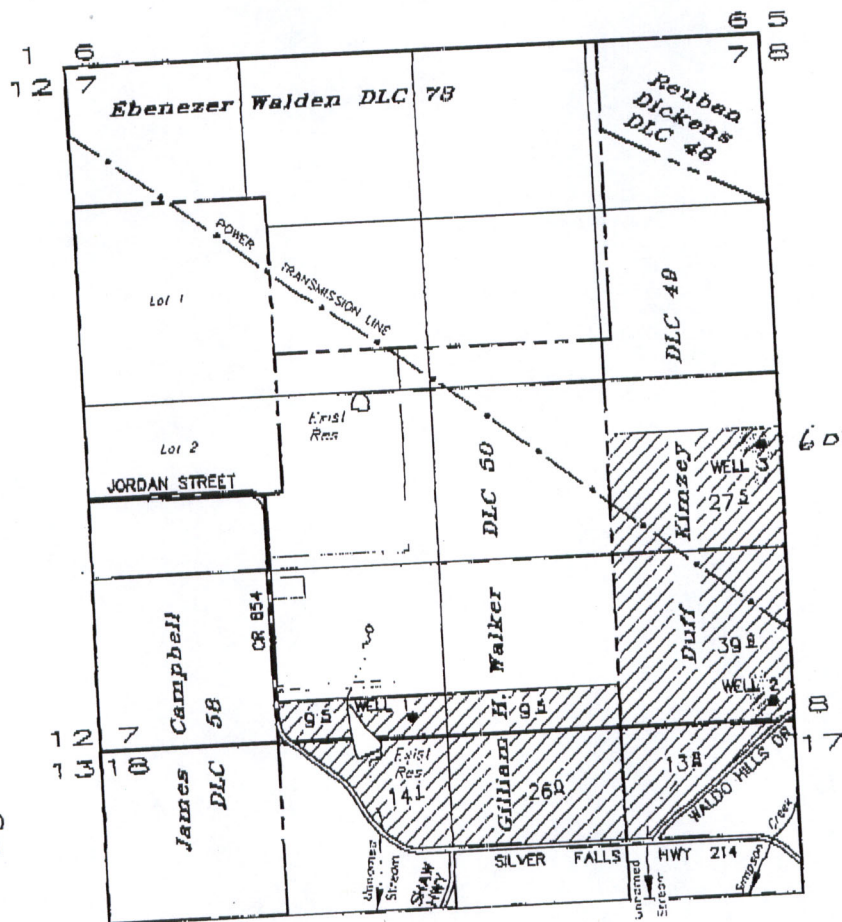
