The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: Greg Tevelde, Willow Creek Dairy, Start Card number 1029838, is hereby approved for the following: You may remove your drill rig from this well site prior to completing the well as described on your Special Standards Request Form. ***A condition of this Special Standards Request approval is that a drilling rig returns to the site to complete the well within six weeks of the date of this letter.*** All other well construction and abandonment standards apply. A copy of your Special Standards Request Form is enclosed.

Verbal approval of this Special Standards Request was provided on May 26, 2016.

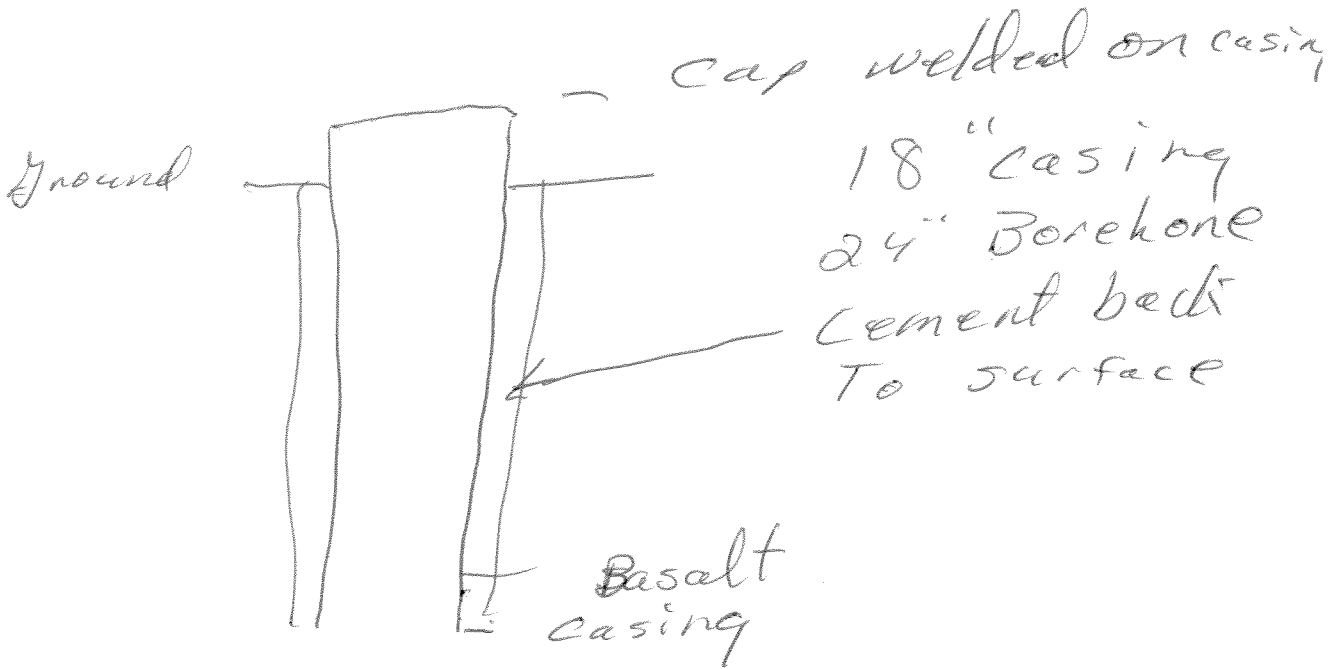

- (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior oral approval.
