### FINAL ORDER


Dear Mr. Coley:

The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: Three Valleys Ranch, Start Card number 206270, is hereby approved for the following: You may install the liner in this well as described on your Special Standards Request Form (Enclosed). All other construction requirements must be adhered to.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.

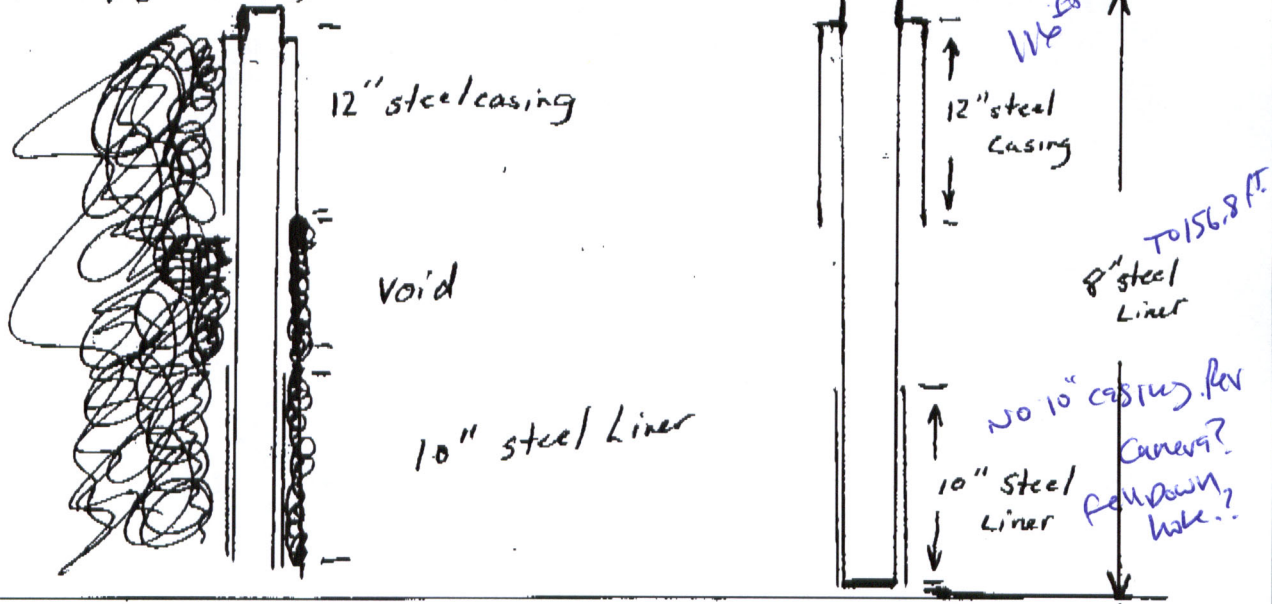

- (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior approval.
