## FINAL ORDER


Dear Floyd:

The Special Standard request you submitted for owner: City of Keizer, Start Card number 205269, is hereby approved for the following: After verifying that the well is clean to the natural bottom, you may abandon this water supply well as described on your Special Standard Request Form (enclosed). All other well abandonment standards must be adhered to. A copy of your Special Standard Request Form is enclosed.

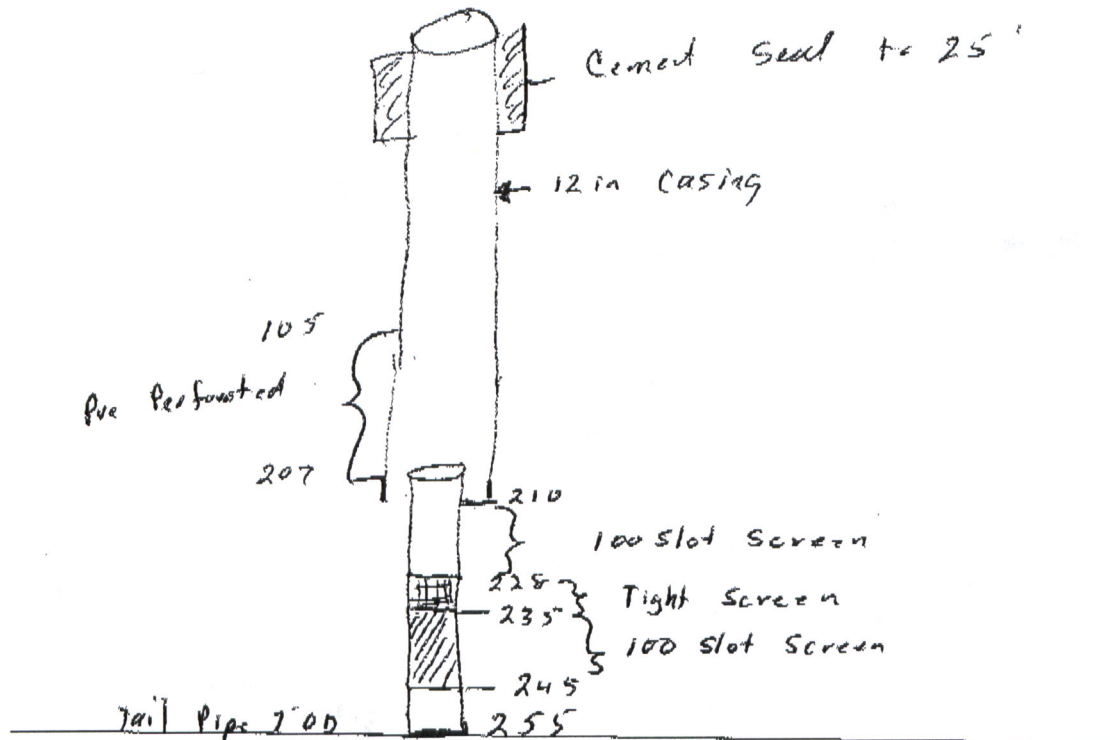

- (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior oral approval.
