
Dear Mr. Adamson:

The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: Ken Casper, Start Card number 199995, is hereby approved for the following: After verifying that it is clean to the natural bottom, you may abandon this well in-place with cement grout as described on your Special Standards Request Form (See OAR 690-220-0030 and 690-220-0040). Your Special Standards Request Form is enclosed. All other standards must be adhered to.

By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. - (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior oral approval.
