The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: City of Dundee, Start Card number 208756, is hereby approved for the following: You may partially abandon this water supply well (Original Log YAMH 54149) as described on your Special Standards Request Form. All other well construction standards apply. Your Special Standards request form is enclosed. Verbal approval of this Special Standards Request was provided on April 17, 2014.

(5) The unusual site conditions which necessitate this request: We are partially abandoning YAMH
54149 to prevent commingling from upper formations down to approximately 660'. We removed the 6" liner
and now have slough & pea gravel in bottom of hole. Top of slough is at approximately 786'.

(6) The proposed construction methods that the bonded well constructor believes will be adequate for this well: (attach additional pages if needed)
Propose leaving the slough & pea gravel as is. Begin sealant placement from top of slough to the planned depth
of ~560'. Removal of slough-pea gravel risks creating more slough, is costly, would serve no useful purpose
and would result in more sealant plugging a WBZ. Result provides over 200' seal depth over the slough.

- (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior oral approval.
