The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: Port of Morrow, Start Card number 1056580, is hereby approved for the following: You may temporarily remove your drilling machine from this well site as described on your Special Standards Request Form dated December 19, 2022. *The stipulation of this approval is that the drilling machine must be returned to this well site no later than January 31, 2023.* All other well construction standards apply as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-210. A copy of your Special Standards Request Form is enclosed.

Verbal approval of this Special Standards Request was provided on December 7, 2022.
