FINAL ORDER

Dear Mr. Acquistapace:

The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for landowner: Baker, Start Card number: 1039853 is hereby approved for the following: You may remove the drilling machine from the site prior to completion of the well as described on your Special Standards Request Form dated August 15, 2018. The stipulation for the approval of this Special Standards Request is; you must return the drilling machine to the site, to complete the well, immediately, after the camera survey of the well and possibly a flow meter test of the well has been conducted, scheduled for August 24th, 2018, and the casing and sealing depth has been determined by Water Resources Personnel. All other water well construction standards shall apply. A copy of your Special Standards Request Form is enclosed.

Please note that the Special Standards Request must be submitted by the licensed and bonded well constructor to the Well Construction Program Coordinator, and approval granted, prior to commencing any activity that would require a Special Standard Request approval. Failure to comply may result in this matter being forwarded to the Enforcement Section.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.

- (3) If oral approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of oral approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior oral approval.
