FINAL ORDER

Dear Mr. Janssen:

The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: Laurel Acres Water Company Inc., Start Card number 21-4669, is hereby approved for the following: You may construction this water supply well within 67 feet from the nearest septic drain field line as outlined on your Special Standards Request Form dated July 20, 2017. *A condition of Special Standards Request approval is that the well must be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a minimum depth of at least 190 feet below land surface. A deeper seal will need to be placed if required by rule based on the formations encountered. A split seal is not allowed. In addition, the existing well on the site shall be properly decommissioned after the new well is completed and replaces it as the water supply well.* A copy of your Special Standards Request Form is enclosed. All other water supply well construction standards must be adhered to.

Verbal approval of this Special Standard Request was provided on July 24, 2017.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.
