Dear Steve:

The Special Standards Request Form you submitted for owner: City of Stanfield, Start Card number 208746, is hereby approved for the following: You may install this well within 25 feet from a closed sewage line in the location agreed upon with the Department's representative. A stipulation of this special standard is that the well must be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a minimum depth of 900 feet below ground surface as described on your Special Standards Request Form. A deeper seal must be placed, if required, based on the formations encountered while drilling. All other standards must be adhered to. Your Special Standards Request Forms is enclosed.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.




