FINAL ORDER

Dear Bret:

The Special Standard request you submitted for owner: Oregon State Parks, Start Card number 197206, is hereby approved for the following: You may drill this well within 70 feet from the existing septic drainfield. The well shall be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a minimum depth of 70 feet bgs and shall be in the location previously agreed upon. The seal shall be deeper if required by Statute and Rule. This well may not have a split seal (See OAR 690-210-0030). All other construction requirements must be adhered to. A stipulation of this Final Order is that the existing two wells on site that are within setbacks must be permanently abandoned within 90 days of completion of the new well as agreed upon by WRD and State Parks. Your Special Standard request form is enclosed.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.

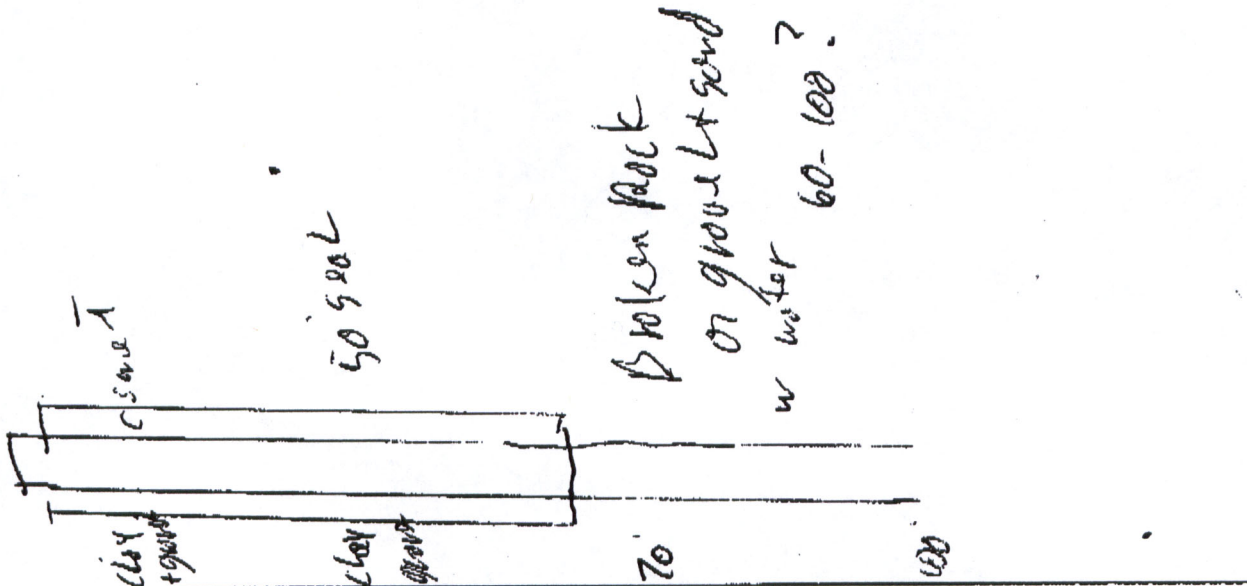
