FINAL ORDER

Dear Mr. Burd:

The Special Standard request you submitted for owner: Port of Morrow, Start Card number 1002810, is hereby approved for the following: You may move your drilling machine off of this well, prior to completion of construction, for fourteen days (from January 9, 2008 until January 23, 2008). The well shall be protected from damage and shall be properly covered so that contaminants do not enter the aquifer. Following January 23rd your drilling machine must be returned to the drill site and the well shall be either completed or abandoned per Oregon's minimum well construction standards (See OAR 690-210-0390). All other well construction requirements apply. Your Special Standard request form is enclosed.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.
