

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Bureau of Land Management (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is North Fork

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Oregon Gulch a side drainage of Jenny Creek
tributary of the Klamath River

3. The amount of water to be stored is less than 1/4 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is stock watering purposes.
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 19, NW 1/4
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)
Tp. 40 S., R. 4 E., W.M., in the county of Jackson

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet
Located in the channel of an intermittent stream. Rock and clay formation at the outlet.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions
a small spring will help to partially fill this reservoir.

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4, Sec. 19,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 40 S., R. 4 E., W.M. The maximum height will be 6 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 99 feet; length on bottom 80 feet; width on top 6 feet; slope on front or water side 2 to 1; slope on back 1 to 1; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Dam was constructed of the surround earth. No protection was required for wave action.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Spillway was around the end of the dam and is ten feet wide and two feet deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Spillway is around the south end.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be less than 1/10 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 4 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 90.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before constructed before this office was advised that a filing was needed. This project was constructed under the provisions of 13. Construction work will be completed on or before the Taylor Grazing Act of June 30, 1934, as amended.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of North Fork Reservoir and storage of water from Oregon Gulch tributary of Jenny Creek for livestock, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.2 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is December 22, 1960

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 10, 1965 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1966
