

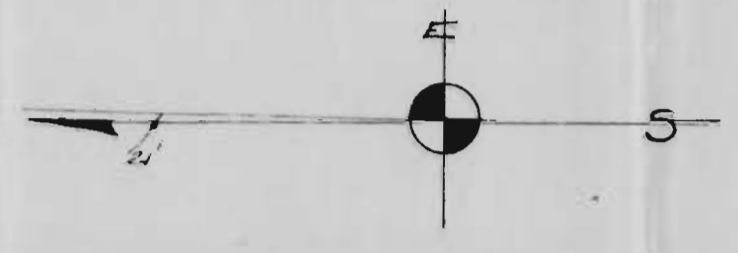

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, John F. Spray and Mary E. Spray, wife  
and co-heiress of the said John F. Spray, do hereby certify that the plat of Cedar Park is a true and correct copy of the  
original and has been laid out by us and no other person, and we have by these presents  
dedicated to the public the trail, boulevard and roadway connecting the present  
county roads, as shown thereon, to be used as such forever.

22.5' E from the NW corner to D.C. 70, and that the boundaries, lots and roads are correctly  
represented on this Plat.
