CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That CARY V. LOOSLEY of Ft. Klamath, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Blue Springs, a tributary of Seven Mile Creek, for the purpose of supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 9122 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 31, 1928, for 2.25 cubic feet per second, and from January 15, 1929, for 2.49 cubic feet per second; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.74 cubic feet per second. The point of diversion is located in the NNASMAT of Section 24, Township 33 South, Range 6 East, W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation, or any other purpose), is as follows:

40 acres in the SWINE1,
40 acres in the SEINE1,
40 acres in the NE2SE1,
59.4 acres in the NW1SE1,
15 acres in the SEISE1,
Section 25,
Township 33 South, Range 6 East, W. M.

40 acres in the SM1NM1.

39.3 acres in the SE1NM1.

39.3 acres in the NE1SM1.

40 acres in the NM1SM1.

22 acres in the SM1SM1.

22 acres in the SE1SM1.

Section 30.

Township 33 South, Range 72 East, W. M.

This right is specifically limited to a period of use extending from May llth to October 1st of each year unless permission is given by the Oregon State Game Commission or the State Engineer to divert water for irrigation earlier than May 1lth, and such permission shall not be given by the State Engineer in any case unless it is found by him that the diversion before May 1lth will not decrive the Oregon State Game Commission of sufficient water for the proper maintenance and operation of its present egg-taking station on Seven Mile Creek.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of Section 47-508, Oregon Code 1920.
