CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That Southern Pacific Company

of Portland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Springs at West Fork, and Cow Creek
for the purpose of Domestic use and railroad purposes

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 1; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1883 for Springs at West Fork and 1908 for
Cow Creek

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of useSE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 2

Twp. 32 S., Rge. 8 W., N.M.

Note: This certificate supersedes and corrects the description of the place of
use as described in certificate recorded in Vol. 9, at page 9672 of State Record
of Water right Certificates. (Supplemental Decree Correcting Original Decree
Volume 12, Page 284).

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
