CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That W. H. McCLURE

of Kernville, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the purpose of the irrigation of 11 acres of land

under Permit No. 197 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 208, on the 12th day of April, 1916; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1909; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Eleven (11) acres in A tract of land beginning at a point on the subdivision line of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Thirty-six (36) South, Range Six (6) West, 109 feet west of Southeast corner of Lot Seven (7), said Section; thence run west along said sectional subdivision line 404.3 feet; thence north 1254 feet to Rogue River; thence north 84 1/2 degrees east along Rogue River 405.7 feet; thence south 1278 feet to place of beginning, containing 11.75 acres, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
