CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOHN ALLSTEAD

of Halfway, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Holbrook Creek, tributary of Pine Creek,
 for the purpose of Irrigation of 9 acres, and domestic and stock water

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 255; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic
 foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limita-
 tion of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August,
 and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

9 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
 Section 24,
 Township 7 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
