Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 235; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 80 miners inches through the Foot Hills Ditch, and 50 miners inches through Curry Ditch.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

35.6 acres in NEANN;
8.8 acres in NWANN;
15.0 acres in SWANN;
39.4 acres in SRANN;

(NOTE: The above described lands have a supplemental supply from Pine Creek through the John S. Curry Ditch with date of priority of 1891.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
