## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 235; that the priority

of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1897 for Tract No. 1, and 1899 for Tract No.2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 1, and 1.0 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
