that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per scre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per scre during July, one acre-foot per acre during Eugust, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.
