This is to Certify, That E. T. DOUGLAS

has a right to the use of

the waters of

Clear Creek, tributary of Pine Creek,

for the purpose of Irrigation of 20.0 acres, and domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 255; that the priority

of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one—fortieth of a cubic foot per second per scre, measured at the point of diverions, with a total limitation of one acre—foot per scre during July, one scre—foot per scre during August, and one—helf acre—foot per scre during September, of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant

(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20.0 acres in Ed of SWASWA,
Section 29,
Township 7 South, Range 46 East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
