and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume
11, at page 255; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from
1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-forticth of a cubic foot per second per sere, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per sere during July, one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per sere during September, of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40.0 acres in NETSET 40.0 acres in NWISET, Section 6, Township 8 South, Range 46 East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
