CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That LENORA G. HUNT
c/o J.E. Lataurette, City Hall, Oregon 19201
of Portland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Pine Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation of 102.8 acres, and domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 235; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1874 for Tract No.1, and 1883 for Tract No.2,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 40 miners inches for
Tract No.1, and one fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the
point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July,
one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during Sept-
ember, of each year, for Tract No. 2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT No. 1
40.0 acres in the NE 1/4, NENE
Section 7,
Township 8 South, Range 46 East, W.M.
37.8 AC NENE
31.6 AC NINE
33.0 AC SW NE
38.3 AC SE NE
TRACT No. 2
37.8 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4
25.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 6,
Township 8 South, Range 46 East, W. M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
