CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That J. H. IRWIE

of Halfway

, State of Oregon,

has a right to the use of

the waters of East Branch of Glear Creek, trib. of Pine Creek, for Tract No. 1; Prong of Glear Creek, trib.of Pine Creek for Tract No.2, and Pine Creek for Tract No.3, for the purpose of Irrigation of 55.0 acres, and domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 235; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1882 for Tracts Nos. 1 and 2; 1886 for Tr.No.3,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per sare, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one sare-foot per sare during July, one sare-foot per sare during Eugust, and one-half sare-foot per sare during September, of each per.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

11.0 scres in NE4SW4
Section 32,
Township 7 South, Range 46 East, W.M.

TRACT No. 2
11.0 acres in SEASW1
8.0 acres in NFGSW2,
Section 32,
Township 7 South, Range 46 East, W.M.

TRACT No. 3
5.0 acres in NW1SE1
Section 8,
Township 8 South, Range 46 East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
