has a right to the use of

the waters of East Pine Creek, and Springs in NWINEL, SWISWI, Sec. 4, Twp.8 S.R.46 E,

for the purpose of Irrigation of 155.0 acres, and domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 235; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877 for Tract No. 1; 1886 for Tract No. 2, and 1914 for Tract No. 5;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
