of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 10291 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 14, 1931;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from the spring and 0.02 cubic foot per second from each stream SEASWA

The point of diversion is located in the NEINWIOF Section 28 33, Township 13 SRange 11 W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-cightieth of one cubic foot per second per

acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

. A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation, or any other purpose), is as follows:

PLACE OF USE:

NEANWA, Section 53, Township 15 South, Range 11 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use

herein described. After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
