This is to Certify, That WILLIAM L. MORFITT

of Unity State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Johns Creek and Bullrun Creek, a tributary of Burnt River

for the purposes of irrigation, under Permit No. 639, Certificate of water right recorded on Page 1048 State Record of Water Right certificates.

said waters to be stored in accordance with ~~ORDER~~ Reservoir Permit No. 99 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 208, on the 12th day of April, 1916; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 12, 1911

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 280 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Sections 20 and 21, Tp. 13 S., R. 37 E., W. M.
