CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That S. M. MEARS and HARRIET H. HOGE

of 14th and Northrup Sts., Portland State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the

waters of Whiskey Creek in Section 1, ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ Township Two North Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian

for the purposes of the irrigation of five acres of land, domestic use, and power sufficient to operate a hydraulic ram, utilizing a fall of ~~xxxx~~ forty feet, under Permit No. 300 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1,

at page 208, on the 12th day of April, 1916; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1910; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 2.69 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Five (5) acres in the East one-half of the Southeast quarter (E 1/2 SE 1/4) of Section One (1), Township Two (2) North Range Ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian, in Hood River County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
