## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to Certify, That** W. C. CREE, (Successor in interest to W.B. Riley)  
 240 Glenwood Street,  
 of Malden, State of Massachusetts has a right to the use of  
 the waters of Deer Creek  
 for the purpose of Irrigation of 75.3 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority  
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from September 18, 1907

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one  
 cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 30.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 4.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
 Section 8,  
 Township 10 South, Range 38 East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
 contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
 of use herein described.
