CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That E. M. LEEVER

of Fort Klamath, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Anna Creek,
 for the purpose of Irrigation of 27.72 acres,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 269; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per
 second from April 1st to July 20th of each year and thereafter until the close of
 the irrigation season 0.18 cubic foot per second, or the equivalent thereof in
 case of rotation; the total quantity delivered not to exceed 3 acre feet for
 each acre irrigated.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

24.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 3.12 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 9,
 T. 33 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decrees.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
