CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. E. NICHOLSON

of Fort Klamath, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Seven Mile Creek for Tract No. 1, and Waste Water from Slough in $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, T. 33 S. R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., W.M. for Tract No. 2,

for the purpose of Irrigation of 158.6 acres in Tract No. 1, and

Supplemental Irrigation for 6 acres in Tract No. 2;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 269; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/50th of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated prior to July 20th and 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated thereafter, and shall not exceed 5 acre feet per acre during irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT No. 1

39.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

39.3 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

40.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

40.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,

Section 20;

T. 33 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East, W. M.

TRACT No. 2 (Supplemental)

6.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 20,

T. 33 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
