and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klemath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 269; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May. 1914:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.85 cubic feet per second during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the piace where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40.0 scres in NELSNI
40.0 scres in NWISWI
40.0 scres in SWISWI
40.0 scres in SELSWI

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
