## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That E. A. GRAHAM

of Sisters, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
 the waters of Dry Creek,  
 for the purpose of irrigation (during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
 Crook Board of Control, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority  
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 cubic foot per  
 second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20.0 acres in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
 20.0 acres in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
 10.0 acres in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>,  
 Section 22,  
 T. 14 S., R. 9 East, W. M.

NOTE: This certificate is to correct and supersede that certain  
 Water Right Certificate issued by the Board of Control on  
 November 29, 1911 to E. A. Graham, and recorded in State  
 Record of Water Right Certificates at Page 277, Vol. 1,  
 so as to correctly describe the source of supply as Dry Creek.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
 of use herein described.
