CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That J. W. McDONOUGH

of Ashland State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of waste and overflow waters of Annie Creek Slough

for the purpose of the irrigation of 320 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 2, at page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1892

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed 4.00 cubic feet per second from April 1st to July 20th of each year and thereafter until the close of the irrigating season 2.00 cubic feet per second, or the equivalent thereof in case of rotation; the total quantity delivered not to exceed three acre feet for each acre irrigated.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 40 acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29) 40 acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 40 acres in Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Thirty-three (33) South, Range Seven and one-half (7 1/2) East of Willamette Meridian, in Klamath County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer. The right to use water for domestic and stock purposes shall continue throughout the year.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
