for the purpose of Irrigation

und that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1869;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed. Three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

27 acres in NW1SW1,
Section 15;
8 acres in SENNW1
20 acres in NE1SW1
40 acres in NW1SE1,
Section 16;
Tp. 3 S., R. 38 E., W.M.
Lots 5, 4, 5 and 6, Block 8, East Addition to La Grande, Oregon, containing 3.4 acres more or less (being in the SW1NW1 of Sec.9, Twp. 3 S., R. 38 E., W.M.)

(NOTE: Same lands are irrigated from the Grande Ronde River through the same ditch under date of 1883.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
