CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That The CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY

of Medford, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of North Fork of Rogue River
for the purpose of Development of 27,591 theoretical horsepower

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from October 8, 1904;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 400 cubic feet per
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6,
Township 33 South,
Range 3 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
