for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use, (irrigation from March 1st to September 20th of each year)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 73; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1891 for the irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres and from 1905 for the irrigation of twenty-three (23) acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic feet per second as of date 1891 and 0.38 cubic feet per second as of date 1905.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Twenty-eight (28) acres in NW4 of NW4; four (4) acres in SW2 of NW4; eight and eighty-seven (8.87) hundredths acres in SE4 of NW4; one (1) acre in NE4 of NW4; two and thirty-nine hundredths (2.39) acres in NE4 of SW4; all in Sec. 17, Tp. 2 S. R. 26 E., W. M., in Morrow County, Oreson.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
