CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JORDAN VALLEY CATTLE COMPANY

Idaho , State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Upper Cow Creek Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-091

a tributary of Jordan Creek for the irrigation of lands already having a partial water right under Permit No. 3247 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 14, 1916;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpose's aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 21.2 cubic feet per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the NEISE;, Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 44 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

80 acres in the S2 SW2, 80 acros in the No NEI, 80 acres in the Sz SEz, 40 acres in the SWINE; Section 15, 25 acres in the NWASER, 40 acres in the SETSET, 160 acres in the NW4, Section 16, 80 acres in the No SW., 40 acres in the SE NEZ, 40 acres in the SWISWI, 30 acres in the SETSWIT, Section 20, 160 acres in the NET, Section 22, 40 acres in the SEANWA, 320 acres in the N2, 80 acres in the N2 SW1, 320 acres in the Sz, 80 nors in the Wa SEL,

Section 28,
Tównship 2: South, Range 44 East, W. M.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
