has made proof , State of. Hemlock to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the , & tributary of Beaver Creek waters of Four unnamed springs , for the purpose of the irrigation of 12 acres of land, and domestic use Permit No. 1973 of the State Engineer, and that said right to under the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, minde and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume , on the 29th day of September, 1916 ; that the priority of at page 225 the right hereby confirmed dates from 14, 1914 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not cubic foot per second. exceed 0.25

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 8 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 4 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Three (3) South, Range Nine (9) West of Willamette Meridian, in Tillamook County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to oneeightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, us hereby confirmed and limited.
