## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That J. D. BROWN,

of Arlington, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to the Columbia River, in Gilliam County, Oregon,

for the purposes of irrigation; (during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 73; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount uctually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.66 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows:

Thirteen (13) acres in NW1 of NE1; twelve (12) acres in SW1 of NE1; four and one-half (41) acres in NE1 of NW1; ten (10) acres in SE2 of NW2; All in Sec. 12, Tp. 3 N. R. 22 E., W. M., in Gilliam County, Oregon.
