## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

domestic use and irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

September 16, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed

0.2 c.f.s. being 0.19 c.f.s for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s for domestic, measured at the point of diversion from the stream,

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the SN1 SN1, Section 3, and SE1 SE1, Section 4, Township 10 South, Range 30 East, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, for each acre irrigated prior to June 1, and thereafter, 1/80th of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated or its equivalent, shall not exceed one acre-foot per acre during any month prior to June 1st, nor exceed a total during the irrigation season from April 1, to Sept. 30 of each year of And shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.7 acres in the NW1SW1, Section 3 Township 1C South, Range 30 East, W. M.

 $SN_1^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $NE_1^{\frac{1}{4}}$ , Section 3, Township 10 South, Range 30 East (domestic use)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1980.
