This Is to Certify, That HENRY C. & SUSANNE HANSEN : Enterprise Oregon , State of , has made proof the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River Grande Ronde River for the purpose of a tributary of Irrigation and Domestic 9697

under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby April 11, 1930; confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.24 cubic feet per second;

or its gravivalent in case of rotation.

NW1 NW2 of Section 5, Township 3 South, Range The point of diversion is located in the 45 East. N. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other existing for the same lands, shall be limited to, one-eightieth one cubic foot per second: right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to on per acre. or its equivalent in case of rotation, per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15 acres in the SET NWT

30 acres in the NET NWI 20 acres in the NWI NWI Section 28

30 acres in the SNA SNA Section 21

Township 1 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

This certificate is to correct and supersede that sertain water right certificate issued by the State Eng. neer on November 28, 1930 to Henry C. and Susanne Hansen, which certificate is recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 8, Page 8944, so as to correctly record and describe the place of use.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
