CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. T. BREWER

of Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of A Fork of Jackson Creek sometimes known as Miller Creek, tributary of Bear Creek, tributary of Rogue River,

for the purposes of Irrigation, Domestic and Mining, water to be appropriated under Permit No. 11126

under Reservoir Permit No. R-670 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1933;

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed one-half acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 35, Tp. 37 S, R. 3 W, W.M.
