CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. T. BREWER

of Nedford , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed gulch and Brewer Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-670 a tributary of Fork of Jackson Cr., sometimes known as Miller Cr. for the purpose of Irrigation, Mining and Domestic under Permit No. 11126 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed l.ll cubic foot per second, being 0.10 second—foot for irrigation, 1.0 second—foot for mining, and 0.01 second—foot for domestic, being 1.01 c.f.s. from reservoir and 0.1 c.f.s. from unnamed gulch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NELSEL of Section 35, Township 37 South, Range 3 West, W. M., and NELNE of Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, \wp as follows:

3 acres and domestic in the SE₄SE₄
Section 35
2 acres and domestic in the SW₂SW₁
Section 36
Township 37 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

3 acres in the NEinEi Section 2

Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Mining in the SW4SW4

Section 36
Township 37 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
