CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT R. CHAPMAN

of Route 1, Milton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Walla Walla River and tributary springs a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 11582 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7, 1935;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.094 cubic foot per second, being 0.032 second-foot from springs and 0.062 second-foot from Walla Walla River,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 5 North, Range 36 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-thirtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.3 acres in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4  
1.2 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
Section 25  
Township 5 North, Range 36 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
