CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That HAROLD H. HURSH and MARGUERITE E. HURSH

of Huntington, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Durbin Creek for Tract #1; Burnt River for Tract #2, for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1864 for Tract #1; 1866 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes herein resaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season, (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 64 of said Decree.)

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT #1

2 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 12, T. 14 S., R. 44 E., W. 4.

4 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12;
T. 14 S., R. 44 E., W. 4.

(NOTE: 15 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 8 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 also irrigated from Durbin Creek under date of 1864.)

(This Certificate is issued to supersede that certain certificate issued to Lucinda J. South, July 19, 1927, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 7, page 7247, the right for 5 acres of land under said certificate having been transferred to Oregon Portland Cement Company by Order of the State Engineer dated Feb. 27, 1939 under the provisions of Sec. 47-712, Oregon Code, 1935 Supplement.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
