CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That OREGON PORTLAND CEMENT COMPANY

of Huntington, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Burnt River
for the purpose of Manufacturing

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1866

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-eighth of a
cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(This Certificate is issued in accordance with an order of the
State Engineer dated Feb. 27, 1939, under the provisions of
Section 47-712 Oregon Code, 1935 Supplement, approving the
transfer to the above Company of a portion of the water right
recognized by Decree of the Court in the Burnt River adjudica-
tion in the name of Huntington Meat Company, and supersedes
that certain certificate issued to Lucinda T. South (successor
to Huntington Meat Company) July 19, 1927, and recorded in
State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 7, page 7247.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
