**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**    **CAREY S. STEARNS**

of        **Lapine**        , State of        **Oregon**        , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Long Prairie Slough** a tributary of **Little Deschutes River**        for the purpose of **irrigation** under Permit No.    **2611**        of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 24, 1915;**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 10 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**PLACE OF USE:**

20 acres in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**   
Section 2,  
Township 22 South, Range 10 East, W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede that certain water right certificate issued to J. Frank Bogue, May 22, 1931, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 8, Page 9101, and in Miscellaneous Records of Deschutes County, Oregon, Volume 3, Page 208, and to confirm a change in place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer dated September 16, 1938, pursuant to Section 47-712, Oregon Code 1935 Supplement.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
