CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of South Junction , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Deschutes River a tributary of Columbia River

for the purpose of

Irrigation
under Permit No. 11592 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 22, 1935;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SELSEL of Section 9 and Lot 1 (SWLSWL) of Section 10, Township 8 South, Renge 14 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from May 23, to August 20 of each year; 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre after August 20 of each year, or its equivalent, shall not exceed four acre feet per acre during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.9 acres in Lot 1 (SW4SW4)
Section 10
0.9 acre in Lot 5 (SE4SE4)
Section 9
Township 8 South, Range 14 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
